Eighty per cent of the bulbs are from Holland and the rest from New Zealand, Chile, Brazil and France, which means that we can deliver fresh bulbs year-round. Through collaborations with several growers, we are able to offer exclusive varieties and the latest assortment of products on the market.

All treatments to our flower bulbs are done under our own management. Also we test the flower bulbs in our greenhouse by planting samples. New varieties on the market are planted as well to check for compliance with our flower bulb quality requirements.

It is wonderful to visit our customers all over the world and see our products flowering. These moments are very rewarding to us. No matter the season, place or time, we can always guarantee the best possible quality, and that makes us very proud.
